

CANADIAN PM TRUDEAU VISITS PARIS AND SIGNS PARTNERSHIPS WITH PDT MACRON

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USPA NEWS - Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau is visiting from Monday in Paris to meet the President of the Republic and Emmanuel Macron, his Prime Minister. He explained during the statement the Press at the Elysee Palace that the friendship that binds him with Emmanuel Macron, dating back to the time when they knew each other even before being elected. Prime Minister Trudeau spoke both in English and in French, where he expressed himself in an easy way and the interests of the ECSC agreement, which "reflect the progressive values "of Canada" and which are aligned with those of France and Europe. President Macron has guaranteed his support during the next G7 organization to be held in Charlevoix and recalled the major international meetings "We also talked about international actions G7, G20 and NATO. " The two heads of state recalled the application of the Paris agreement on climate and the establishment of the trade treaty between the European Union and Canada,-----

It should be remembered that the ECSC was strongly criticized by a part of civil society and on which national parliaments are called upon to vote. Ironically, Nicolas Hulot strongly opposed the CECA, on behalf of his Hulot Foundation in 2016, before becoming Minister of the Environment, and led to sign a partnership with Canada today to the Elysee.

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
